Bangladesh Scouts will send a contingent to this event. The interested applicants are requested to apply within 20th January 2017 to National Headquarters, Bangladesh Scouts. Venue : Iceland
Reg. Fee : USD 250.00 for all

Eligibility:

Adult Leader : Minimum Wood-badge holder
(Age: 26+, born on or before 1st Aug 1991)
Rover Scouts : Minimum Training Stage
(Age: 18-25 years old, born between 2nd Aug 1992 and 25th Jul 1999)

Expenditure: An approx. amount of Tk. =2,00,00.00 (Two lac taka only) including visa fee, air fare may be required to attend the 15th World Scout Moot in Iceland. Participants themselves will have to bear all expenses related to the attendance of this event and Bangladesh Scouts will have no any financial involvement.

Submission of Application: All interested applicants are requested to send the duly filled application forms through proper channel to the National Headquarters of Bangladesh Scouts **on or before 20th January 2017**. Bangladesh Scouts will not entertain any application after the deadline.
